6. What do you know about Grace Lutheran in the Grace Center building?
(Grace Center is the former Holland Elementary School building at 1500 6th St. NE.)
7. If you wanted to learn more about Grace Lutheran, where would you look?
8. Is there anything else you'd like to share?
(For example: about Northeast, faith communities, or what we didn't think to ask you.)
9. Who would you recommend we speak with next?
